Commentary

Prices across many grades ended up lower than they were last week.

As we enter the summer period, there isn't a lot of enthusiasm in the market at present as recent trends have tended to be downward.

With school holidays either started or starting from today, many will be going on holiday, and that will mean the traditional slowdown for the summer break.

Europe in particular tends to take much of August off so the expectation now is that the market will be quieter until at least September.

As a result, there isn't a huge amount of demand coming for certain paper grades, plastics and steel and aluminum cans. Glass though has improved in recent weeks.

Shipping rates appear to be stable at the moment for those exporting. The pound was unchanged against the dollar at \$1.29 and also the euro at €1.18 compared to last week.
